Requires residential and commercial solid waste be separated (HSCR883-20) by source and processed at appropriate facilities. Requires Status & each county to submit a revised integrated solid waste Testimony management plan by 1/1/2021. Establishes a 2030 waste stream reduction goal. Appropriates funds to the counties for

solid waste management programs. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
