Status & support agriculture in the State. Authorizes any moneys appropriated to be transferred to the Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2020.

SB 2702 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AEN, WAM

Testimony

Temporarily authorizes the Board of Agriculture to decide on a case-by-case basis which entities qualify for a non-agricultural park lease. Establishes conditions and qualifications for a lease. Sunsets 6/30/2025.

SB 2703 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AEN, WAM

Status & Creates a grant program and appropriates funding for a program to assist beginning farmers and ranchers to start farm or ranch operations.

SB 2705 RELATING TO THE IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LAND AEN, WAM QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL COST TAX CREDIT.

Status & Extends the time that the department of agriculture may certify important agricultural lands qualified agricultural costs from 2021

to 2030.

SB 2708  Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL ENTERPRISES. Authorizes the Department of Agriculture to plan, design, construct, operate, manage, maintain, repair, demolish, and remove infrastructure on any lands under the jurisdiction of the department, to support and promote agriculture. Establishes the agricultural enterprise program. Establishes the Agricultural Enterprise Special Fund. Makes an appropriation. Effective 7/1/2020.	AEN, WAM/JDC
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.  Makes an appropriation to fund 1 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) agricultural appraiser position within the Department of Agriculture.	AEN, WAM
SB 2711 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.  Appropriates funds to the Department of Agriculture to establish a foreign agriculture small equipment pilot program. Requires a report to the Legislature.	AEN, WAM
SB 2716 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE ANIMAL INDUSTRY SPECIAL FUND. Adding new sources of revenue generated by the state veterinary laboratory and animal disease control that can be deposited into the Animal Industry Special Fund.	AEN, WAM
Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE. Appropriates funds to the Department of Agriculture for feral pig control.	AEN, WAM
SB 2824 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.  Appropriates moneys to the Department of Agriculture for 3 full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) inspectors to perform meat inspection services.	AEN, WAM
