SB 677, SD1<br/>(SSCR2929)RELATING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY.StatusProhibits specified trolleys, pulleys, cables, or running lines designed<br/>to attach a dog to two stationary objects in a configuration that<br/>endangers the dog, including by depriving the dog of sustenance.<br/>Prohibits tethering or restraining a dog under the age of six months<br/>unless the dog is engaged in an activity supervised by its owner or an<br/>agent of its owner. Prohibits tethering or restraining a dog with a tow<br/>or log chain if the tow or log chain inhibits the free movement of the<br/>dog. Prohibits tethering or restraining a dog with a choke collar, pinch<br/>collar, or prong collar unless the dog is engaged in an activity<br/>supervised by its owner. Effective 10/1/2020.<br/>(SD1)
