<u>SB 2413</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX EXEMPTIONS. Establishes general excise tax exemptions for food, medical services, and feminine hygiene products.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 2340</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE. Establishes an outreach program in the department of health to inform physicians and appropriate non-physician practitioners participating in medicare that comprehensive care planning services for those with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias is a covered benefit under medicare. <u>SB 2352</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE SAFE HAVEN LAW. Requires and appropriates funds for the department of health to engage in a public awareness campaign on the safe haven law in the State.	CPH, WAM
<u>SB 2033</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE. Amends the effect of finding a defendant charged with a misdemeanor or petty misdemeanor not involving violence or attempted violence unfit to proceed. Amends the requirements for fitness determination hearings, court-appointed examiners, and examination reports.	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 2244</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION. Clarifies the meaning of "program or activity receiving state financial assistance". Excludes cases within the scope of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act from the jurisdiction of the Hawaii civil rights commission.	CPH, JDC

RELATING TO GENDER EQUITY. Requires publicly held domestic and foreign corporations to includes certain numbers of females among their boards of directors. Authorizes administrative fines for noncompliance.
