HB 1602, HD1 (HSCR788-20) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HUMAN REMAINS. Includes the use of natural organic reduction as a method for the disposal of human remains. Amends the procedures for the resolution of disputes regarding the right of disposition, the right to rely and act upon written instructions in a funeral service agreement or similar document, and provisions for the disposition of a decedent's remains and recovery of reasonable expenses to include natural organic reduction facilities. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>HB 2562, HD2</u> (HSCR1018-20) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO COMMON INTEREST COMMUNITIES. Specifies the manner in which a member of a board of a planned community association or condominium association may resign. Limits a planned community association board's ability to fill a vacancy. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD2)	CPH, JDC
HB 2563, HD1 (HSCR1014-20) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS. Exempts planned community associations from certain requirements regarding cumulative voting for and the removal of directors under the Hawaii Nonprofit Corporations Act. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (HD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>HB 2323, HD2</u> (HSCR799-20) <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE MORTGAGE LOAN RECOVERY FUND. Expands the pool of persons eligible to receive restitution from the Mortgage Loan Recovery Fund. Authorizes the Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to issue orders for restitution. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD2)	CPH, WAM
HB 2454, HD1 (HSCR931-20) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CRITICAL ELECTRICAL INFRASTRUCTURE. Establishes the offense of criminal trespass on critical electrical infrastructure. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (HD1)	CPH, JDC
HB 2726, HD1 (HSCR880-20) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR. Includes certain spirits-based beverages in the definition of cooler beverage. Establishes a separate tax rate for beer for small craft producer pubs. Takes effect on 7/1/2112. (HD1)	CPH, WAM/JDC

HB 1109, HD1 (HSCR877) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY. Establishes procedures and eligibility criteria for a privilege to practice public accountancy in this State for public accountants and certified public accountants licensed in another state with comparable education, examination, and experience requirements. Subjects all holders of a privilege to practice to the regulatory and enforcement jurisdiction of the Board of Accountancy. (HB1109 HD1)	CPH, WAM
HB 1678, HD1 (HSCR973-20) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO MUSICAL PERFORMANCES. Prohibits a person from advertising or conducting a live musical performance or production through the use of a false, deceptive, or misleading affiliation, connection, or association with a performing group and recording group. Allows a court to grant restitution. Effective 7/1/2030. (HD1)	CPH, JDC/WAM
