SB 2257 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDU, JDC/WAM Amends the minimum qualifications for nominees to the State Status & Public Charter School Commission to require residency in the **Testimony** State. Provides that commission members may be reimbursed for necessary and reasonable travel expenses incurred in the conduct of official commission business. RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDU, WAM **SB 2057** Gives students enrolling in career and technical programs a Status & preference or district exceptions for those programs in schools **Testimony** outside of the service area in which the student resides. RELATING TO TAXATION. **SB 2261** EDU, WAM Provides an income tax exclusion for certain public school Status & teachers who earn \$60,000 or less per year. Defines eligible **Testimony** teachers as school teachers, special education teachers, school librarians and school counselors employed by the DOE or a charter school. **SB 2052** RELATING TO LOAN FORGIVENESS FOR EARLY EDU, WAM CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROFESSIONALS. Status & Adds early childhood education students to the Hawaii educator **Testimony** loan program to allow the education loans of those individuals to be forgiven after an appropriate number of years teaching in early childhood education. Appropriates funds. RELATING TO SERVICE-LEARNING. EDU, WAM **SB 2295** Requires the Department of Education to implement a service-Status & learning curriculum to develop student character, values, self-**Testimony** esteem, civic responsibility, and knowledge of local community issues and concerns though community service volunteer work. **SB 2256** RELATING TO TEACHER RECRUITMENT. EDU, WAM Authorizes the department of education to provide incentives to Status & enhance the recruitment and retention of public school teachers. Testimony

SB 2263 RELATING TO EDUCATION. EDU, JDC Broadens the scope of profit-making activities pupils can engage Status & in at schools to include commercial enterprises. Testimony **SB 2063** RELATING TO AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS. EDU, WAM Establishes the Hawaii After-School Program for Youth within Status & the Department of Education community engagement branch to **Testimony** provide after school programs for children in grades six through eight. Appropriates funds. **SB 2264** RELATING TO SCHOOL LUNCH REFORM. EDU, WAM Increases the number of days by which students have to apply Status & for free or reduced lunch and to replenish the student's meal **Testimony** fund. Requires the department of education to report to the legislature regarding the number of students who are denied meals based on the inability to pay. Appropriates funds to the special school lunch fund. RELATING TO SAFETY EQUIPMENT. **SB 2271** EDU, JDC/WAM Requires Department of Education school football programs to Status & ensure that each non-new football helmet used in a football Testimony program is reconditioned and recertified at least once every 2 years. Establishes fines and other penalties for failure to properly recertify football helmets. Establishes the football helmet recertification special fund.
