transit-oriented development area, it shall be the responsibility of the electric utility company to install the infrastructure or equipment.

#### RELATING TO GAS.

EEP/HSG, CPC,

**Status** 

Beginning January 1, 2022, requires all residential dwellings that are serviced by gas utilities to be constructed with gas detection systems

installed. Requires sellers of residential real property to provide notice

of the potential hazards of gas appliances.
