SB2805 RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF PLANNING. WTL/EET, CPH

Status and Testimony Requires the office of planning to prepare a comprehensive

renewable energy siting plan. Requires report to the legislature.

SB2780 RELATING TO OFFSHORE DRILLING. WTL/EET, JDC

Status and Testimony Prohibits offshore drilling for oil or natural gas in state marine

waters. Prohibits issuance of permits for or in connection with the

development or operation of any facility or infrastructure associated with offshore drilling for oil or natural gas in state

waters.

SB2915 RELATING TO LIFEGUARD SERVICES AT STATE PARK EET/WTL, WAM

Status and Testimony BEACHES.

Allocates Transient Accommodations Tax revenues to the Department of Land and Natural Resources to cover lifeguard

service expenses incurred at state park beaches.

SB3061 RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EET/WTL, WAM

Status and Testimony AUTHORITY.

Amends the nominating authority of the representatives of the Heeia community development district, Kalaeloa community

development district, and Kakaako community development district

on the Hawaii community development authority.

SB2527 Status and Testimony RELATING TO BROADBAND SERVICE INFRASTRUCTURE. Establishes the broadband service infrastructure grant program to award grants to applicants to extend deployment of facilities used to provide broadband service to unserved and underserved areas of the State. Makes an appropriation.
