Requires the stadium authority to submit annual comprehensive status reports to the legislature. Authorizes the stadium authority to acquire and hold title to real property. Exempts land to which the stadium authority holds title from the definition of "public lands". Transfers authority to issue leases of lands within the stadium development district from the Hawaii community development authority to the stadium authority, including expenditure of general funds and issuance of revenue and general revenue bonds proceeds provided by Act 268, SLH 2019. Authorizes the stadium authority, with approval from the governor, to delegate to other state agencies implementation of capital improvement projects,	LAB, FIN

under certain conditions. Repeals part IX of chapter 206E, HRS, relating to the stadium development district. Broadens the representation of the stadium authority by adding two members to its membership. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
