Requires DOH to investigate care facilities reportedly operating without an appropriate certificate or license, and to take action on confirmed findings of uncertified or unlicensed operation. Includes social workers, navigators, and individual discharge planners in the group of professionals prohibited from knowingly referring or transferring patients to an uncertified or unlicensed facility. Repeals

landlord exclusion.
