## DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB2695 RELATING TO HOUSING. HOU, WAM

Status and Testimony Creates the housing incentive fund to be administered by the

Hawaii public housing authority. Allows the fund to be seeded with general obligation bonds. Creates a tax credit for individuals or

corporations who contribute to the fund.

SB2694 RELATING TO THE LOW-INCOME HOUSING TAX CREDIT. HOU, WAM

<u>Status and Testimony</u> Changes tax credit allocation for partnerships and corporations.

Makes inoperative at risk and passive activity loss rules with

respect to certain low-income building.

SB2852 RELATING TO THE HOUSING LOAN AND MORTGAGE HOU, WAM

Status and Testimony PROGRAM.

Increases the Hula Mae Multifamily Revenue Bond authorization ceiling amount to continue financing affordable rental housing

statewide.

SB3062 RELATING TO THE CONVEYANCE TAX. HOU, WAM

Status and Testimony Increases the cap to be paid into the rental housing revolving fund

from Conveyance Tax revenues.

SB3138 RELATING TO HOUSING. HOU, WAM

Status and Testimony Removes limit on costs eligible for exemption from general excise

tax for development costs of affordable rental housing certified by

the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation.

SB2044 RELATING TO HOUSING SAVINGS ACCOUNTS. HOU, JDC/WAM

Status and Testimony Establishes the procedures for a housing savings account for all

employees in the State.

RELATING TO HOUSING ELEMENTS.

Requires each county to prepare a housing supply plan to plan for projected increases in the State's housing supply to meet housing demands of the respective county, identify and analyze existing and projected housing needs for all income levels, and identify adequate sites for housing, including rental housing.

Status and Testimony

RELATING TO IMPORTANT HOUSING LANDS.

Establishes that important housing lands are public lands owned by the State that are located within 0.5 miles of any rail mass transit station and needed to promote the expansion of available housing for the future. Requires the State and counties to identify and designate important housing lands. Appropriates funds.
