medicaid enrollees. Requires maximization of federal matching funds.

HB 2522 Status

HSH/HLT, FIN

Requires DOH to establish short-term residential beds for the purpose of stabilization from mental health conditions or substance use and to assess patients and triage them to a clinically appropriate level of care through the Hawaii coordinated access resource entry system

(CARES). Appropriates funds.
