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<u>HB 1809</u>	RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.	IAC, CPC
<u>Status</u>	Prohibits residential contractors from offering to pay, in any monetary form, a homeowners insurance deductible as an incentive to encourage the homeowner to hire the contractor. Allows an insured to rescind a contract to repair or replace roof systems or other exterior work within five business days of receiving notice from a homeowners insurer that all or part of the claim or contract is not a covered loss under an homeowners insurance policy.	
<u>HB 2435</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO LICENSURE. Permits a licensed beauty operator to apply for a barber shop license.	IAC, CPC

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
