<u>SB 2076, SD1</u> (SSCR2873) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION REVIEWS. Allows the Office of Hawaiian Affairs consultation with State Historic Preservation Division to delegate to the impacted counties the responsibility for historic preservation project reviews, provided that certain requirements are met. (SD1)	LCA/WTL, JDC
<u>SB 2111, SD1</u> (SSCR2483) <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION. Adds the chairperson of the Hawaiian Homes Commission or the chairperson's designee and the chairperson of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands to serve as ex officio, voting members of the Commission on Water Resource Management. (SD1)	WTL/HWN, JDC
<u>SB 2118</u> (SSCR2614) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO DISCRETIONARY TRANSFERS TO THE SUPREME COURT. Allows child custody appeals to be transferred from the Intermediate Court of Appeals to the Supreme Court, except in cases brought under the Child Protective Act.	HMS, JDC
<u>SB 2119</u> (SSCR2611) <u>Status &amp;</u> Testimony	RELATING TO THE ROOM CONFINEMENT OF CHILDREN AT DETENTION AND SHELTER FACILITIES. Limits the circumstances under which children and minors at shelters may be subject to room confinement, and specifies the conditions and time limits for which room confinement may be imposed.	HMS, JDC

<u>SB 2136</u> (SSCR2620) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Requires the sellers of residential real property to provide smoke alarms in the building.	PSM/CPH, JDC
<u>SB 2139</u> (SSCR2428) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO VACANCIES. Amends filing deadlines for candidates attempting to fill vacant state senate seats.	GVO, JDC
<u>SB 2180, SD1</u> (SSCR2325) <u>Status &amp;</u> Testimony	RELATING TO EXECUTIVE PARDONS. Establishes a comprehensive process for the consideration of executive pardons. (SD1)	PSM, JDC
SB 2188, SD1 (SSCR2648) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO WILDLIFE OFFENSES. Provides that all animal parts, products, or items containing prohibited animal parts or products involved in the commission of wildlife trafficking or certain hunting offenses shall be considered contraband to be forfeited to and disposed of by the State. (SD1)	WTL, JDC
<u>SB 2192, SD1</u> ( <u>SSCR2615)</u> <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HAWAIIAN EXPERTISE IN LAND USE AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT. Prohibits council, board, and commission members from serving if the member has not completed, within the requisite time, the required training course related to native Hawaiian and Hawaiian traditional and customary rights, native Hawaiian and Hawaiian natural resource protection and access rights, and the public trust, including the State's trust responsibility. Requires that at least 4 members each of the board of land and natural resources and the state land use commission be appointed from a list submitted by the office of Hawaiian affairs. (SD1)	HWN/WTL, JDC
<u>SB 2193</u> (SSCR2390) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION. Limits the convictions that may be used in employment decisions from all convictions in the most recent ten years to felony convictions that occurred in the most recent five years and misdemeanor convictions that occurred in the most recent three years.	LCA, JDC
<u>SB 2249, SD1</u> (SSCR2849) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION. Makes it a civil and administrative violation for any person to engage in certain archaeological activities without obtaining the required permission or approval from the department of land and natural resources. (SD1)	LCA, JDC
<u>SB 2260</u> (SSCR2344) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION CARDS. Repeals the minimum age requirement to obtain a civil identification card in the State.	TRS, JDC

<u>SB 2354, SD1</u> (SSCR2603) <u>Status &amp;</u> Testimony	RELATING TO DECEPTIVE PRACTICES. Prohibits a person from advertising or conducting a live musical performance through the use of deceptive affiliation under certain conditions. Enables action against deceptive practices by imposing penalties and private right of action. (SD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 2402, SD1</u> (SSCR2857) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. Authorizes a court to order the forfeiture of Employees' Retirement System benefits of an ERS member, former member, or retirant upon conviction of the individual for a felony related to the State or county employment of the individual. Authorizes designated beneficiaries to receive ERS benefits upon the death of the ERS member, former member, or retirant convicted of the felony. (SD1)	LCA, JDC
SB 2512, SD1 (SSCR2846) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO VETERINARY MEDICINE. Prohibits the owner of an animal, and the owner's employees, from performing any surgical procedure, including but not limited to surgical birth, ear cropping, tail docking, or debarking on the animal without being licensed as a veterinarian. Makes intentionally or knowingly performing any surgical procedure on a pet animal by any person not licensed as a veterinarian guilty of a class C felony. Specifies that accepted veterinary practices and cropping or docking as customarily practiced, shall not be considered cruelty to animals in the first degree if performed by a licensed veterinarian. (SD1)	CPH, JDC
<u>SB 2554, SD1</u> (SSCR2874) <u>Status &amp;</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH. Requires employers to educate employees regarding seizure first aid with information provided by department of labor and industrial relations. (SD1)	LCA, JDC
<u>SB 2573, SD1</u> (SSCR2715) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS. Requires all public meetings of the Board of Regents to be recorded in live digital audio format by May 1, 2020, and in digital video beginning September 1, 2020. Requires all recording to be archived and made available to the public. Requires the Board of Regents to determine its accessibility obligations pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act and comply with those obligations. (SD1)	HRE/TEC, JDC
<u>SB 2664, SD1</u> (SSCR2366) <u>Status &amp;</u> Testimony	RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION. Requires the Board of Education to hold no less than six community forums annually, with at least one forum in each county. Requires the Board to include an open forum for public comments on non-agenda items. Requires a report to the Legislature on implementing open forums. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	EDU, JDC
