RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

(SSCR2581) Status & Testimony	Authorizes the examiner of drivers to accept driver's license renewal applications from civilian employees and contractors of the federal Department of Defense more than six months prior to the date of expiration under certain conditions.	,
SB 2106, SD1 (SSCR2397) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CHILD PASSENGER RESTRAINTS. Amends requirements for child passengers. Requires rear facing child safety seats for children under two years of age. Raises certain fines for violations. (SD1)	TRS, JDC
SB 2166, SD1 (SSCR2398) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY. Requires vehicles on a two-lane highway, behind which a certain number of vehicles are formed in a line, to pull over where possible to let the trailing vehicles proceed when passing is unsafe. (SD1)	TRS, JDC
SB 2233, SD1 (SSCR2536) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES. Requires the examiner of drivers to disqualify any person from driving a commercial motor vehicle for life if that person uses a commercial motor vehicle in the commission of a felony involving an act or practice of severe forms of trafficking in persons. (SD1)	TRS/CPH, JDC

SB 2234 RELATING TO THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE TRS, JDC OPERATING A VEHICLE. (SSCR2501) Lowers the threshold blood alcohol concentration for the offense of operating a vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant. Status & **Testimony** RELATING TO IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES. SB 2329, SD1 TRS/PSM, JDC Requires consecutive terms of imprisonment for anyone (SSCR2757) convicted as a repeat or habitual offender if arising from same conduct as conviction for operating a vehicle without an interlock Status & ignition device. Requires any person operating a vehicle with an **Testimony** ignition interlock to have government issued identification in their immediate possession. Expands the lookback period under provisions relating to ignition interlock requirements from five to ten years. Amends the sentencing guideline to be between six months and one year. Expands the offense of circumventing or tampering with an ignition interlock to include obscuring the camera lens. (SD1) SB 2508, SD1 RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE. TRS, JDC Replaces the term "accident" with collision for purposes of (SSCR2504) certain provisions of the statewide traffic code. (SD1) Status & **Testimony** RELATING TO CROSSWALKS. **SB 2672** TRS, JDC Requires a vehicle approaching a crosswalk from the opposite (SSCR2506) direction of another vehicle stopped at that crosswalk to yield and not proceed until a pedestrian, if any, has crossed the Status & roadway. **Testimony SB 2992** RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES. TRS, JDC Permanently authorizes the Department of Transportation under (SSCR2508) certain conditions to designate shoulders upon which the Department may authorize the driving of motorcycles. Status & **Testimony** TRS, JDC **SB 2993** RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES. Aligns the commercial driver's license qualification standards (SSCR2538) with federal regulations by repealing language related to medical Status & waivers due to diabetes. Makes conforming amendments to **Testimony** Code of Federal Regulation citations. SB 2994, SD1 RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY. TRS/PSM, JDC Establishes the Photo Red Light Imaging Detector Systems (SSCR2679) Program (Program). Authorizes counties to administer the Program. Requires proceeds of fines to be expended in the Status & county from which they were collected for operation of the **Testimony** Program. (SD1) RELATING TO ELECTRIC FOOT SCOOTERS. SB 2995, SD1 TRS/PSM, JDC Establishes a framework for the regulation of electric foot (SSCR2583) scooters by the State and counties. Amends definitions of Status & "moped" to exclude electric foot scooters. (SD1)

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES. TRS/PSM, JDC

Status & **Testimony**

Prohibits a person from intentionally or knowingly manufacturing, importing, installing, reinstalling, distributing, selling, or offering for sale any counterfeit supplemental restraint system component, nonfunctional airbag, or airbag that does not meet federal safety requirements. Prohibits a person from intentionally or knowingly selling, offering for sale, installing, or reinstalling in a motor vehicle any device that causes the motor vehicle's diagnostic systems to fail to warn that the motor vehicle is equipped with a counterfeit supplemental restraint system component or nonfunctional airbag or that no airbag is installed, as applicable. (SD1)

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRS, JDC **SB 3173**

Increases the minimum and potential maximum fine for violating (SSCR2539) Hawaii Revised Statutes sections 291-22, 291-24, and 291-24.5,

which prohibit the installation and sale of noisy mufflers. Status &

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION. PSM/TRS, JDC

> Provides that any authorization by a county director of finance for an electronic method of motor vehicle registration, including the acceptance of any supplemental documents in electronic form, shall extend to all types of motor vehicles and intermodal

equipment. Takes effect 1/1/2021. (SD1)
