SB 2253 RELATING TO EQUAL PAY. LCA, JDC Conforms statutory prohibitions against wage discrimination with Status & other prohibitions on employment discrimination. Requires employers to disclose wage ranges to employees and prospective employees. **SB 2312** RELATING TO CIVIL RIGHTS.
