RELATING TO STANDARDIZED TESTING.

LHE/LAB, FIN

Status

Requires each complex area superintendent to submit an annual report to the Board of Education on the number of standardized tests required for each school within the complex area and the amount of

for each school within the complex area and the amount of instructional time devoted to such tests. Requires the Board of Education to inform students and their parents or guardians of ability to opt out of standardized tests. Removes standardized test results as an evaluation metric on performance reviews for teachers or

educational officers.

HB 1915 Status

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

LHE/LAB, FIN

Establishes within the Department of Education a Workforce Readiness Program to provide opportunities for students to earn

associate degrees, workforce development diplomas, pre-

apprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized certificates.

Requires the department to designate schools, including adult

community schools, to participate in the program. Appropriates funds.

HB 2064 Status

RELATING TO TAX CREDIT FOR ON-SITE EARLY CHILDHOOD FACILITIES.

LHE/LAB, FIN

Establishes an income tax credit for employers who create on-site early childhood facilities. Establishes and appropriates funds for 1.0 FTE on-site early childhood facility coordinator position. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/2020.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
