SB 35, SD2 (SSCR3033) Status	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Establishes a pilot safe space program within the alternative learning center program in the department of education to support students by providing twenty-four hours per day seven days per week access to emergency crisis services. Makes an appropriation. (SD2)	LHE, FIN
SB 2295, SD2 (SSCR2893) Status	RELATING TO SERVICE-LEARNING. Requires the Department of Education to implement a service-learning curriculum to develop student character, values, self-esteem, civic responsibility, and knowledge of local community issues and concerns though community service volunteer work. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)	LHE, FIN
SB 2262, SD1 (SSCR2900) Status	RELATING TO THE HAWAII TEACHER STANDARDS BOARD. Amends the powers and duties of the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board to authorize the issuance of certificates for teachers at private schools. (SD1)	LHE, FIN
SB 2485, SD2 (SSCR2914) Status	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Broadens the purposes for which indirect costs incurred by the Department of Education, State Public Charter School Commission, or a charter authorizer from federal grants may be reimbursed. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)	LHE, FIN
