<u>SB 2172</u>	RELATING TO HOUSING DEVELOPMENT.	PSM/HOU, WAM
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Provides to each county legislative body the ability to review and Status & approve land use district boundary amendments for affordable **Testimony** housing projects on 15 acres or less.

**SB 2212** RELATING TO INCLUSIONARY ZONING. PSM/HOU, JDC

Prohibits any law, ordinance, or rule from imposing an Status & inclusionary zoning requirement on housing offered exclusively Testimony for sale in perpetuity to buyers who are residents of the State,

are owner-occupants, and do not own any other real property.

**SB 2214** RELATING TO HOUSING. HOU/PSM. JDC

Requires state or county agencies to issue ministerial permits Status & for housing development projects that meet certain requirements Testimony within sixty days of receipt of a permit application deemed to be

complete by the receiving state or county agency.
