HB 1678 RELATING TO MUSICAL PERFORMANCES. TIA, CPC, FIN

Status Prohibits a person from advertising or conducting a live musical

performance or production through the use of a false, deceptive, or misleading affiliation, connection, or association with a performing group and recording group. Allows a court to grant restitution.

HB 2467 RELATING TO TOURISM. TIA, LMG, FIN

Status Requires the Department of Business, Economic Development, and

Tourism to study the need for a tourism information center in the

Capital District. Appropriates funds.
