SB 2054, SD2 (SSCR3385) RELATING TO INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT

DISTRICTS.

Status

Specifies that the cost of regional infrastructure improvements made by the Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation may be assessed against transit-oriented development projects specifically benefiting from the improvements. Requires the Hawaii Interagency Council for Transit-Oriented Development to review and make recommendations on applications for subaccount funds for infrastructure projects related to transit-oriented development. (SD2)

SB 2809, SD2 (SSCR3054)

RELATING TO TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT.

TRN/HSG, WLH,

Authorizes the Director of Finance to issue general obligation bonds to the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism for certain transit-oriented development projects. Effective 7/1/2050.
