HB 2035 Status RELATING TO NON-AGRICULTURAL PARK LANDS.

WLH, FIN

Requires DLNR to transfer to DOA specified non-agricultural park lands by a specified deadline. Requires DLNR and DOA to jointly report on the status of the land transfer. Amends the definition of

"agricultural activities" used in chapter 166E, HRS.

HB 2358 Status RELATING TO AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND

AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO LEASE PASTURE LANDS ON TERMS THAT PROMOTE COLLABORATIVE BENEFICIAL USE

FOR FORESTRY, WILDLIFE, RECREATIONAL, AND FOOD PRODUCTION PURPOSES.

Authorizes the Board of Land and Natural Resources to amend and extend existing pasture leases and to issue new pasture leases by negotiation in furtherance of public purposes the Department of Land

and Natural Resources is responsible for promoting.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
