HB1612 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. TRN, FIN

Ensures the collection of the state general excise tax in instances in which the transportation of passengers is furnished by common carriers by the use of aircraft when the collection of the tax is not prohibited by federal law. Limits imposition of tax to flights that occur within the airspace of a single island of the

State.

HB1685 RELATING TO TAXATION. EDB, FIN

Establishes an income tax credit for investment in qualified businesses that develop cybersecurity and artificial intelligence.

<u>HB1928</u>	RELATING TO DEVELOPMENT DISTRICTS.
