In consideration of GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE 773 – SUBMITTING FOR CONSIDERATION AND CONFIRMATION TO THE KAHOOLAWE ISLAND RESERVE COMMISSION OF GUBERNATORIAL NOMINEE CARMEN HULU LINDSEY

Governor's Message No. 773 submits for consideration and confirmation, OHA Trustee Carmen Lindsey to serve on the Kaho`olawe Island Reserve Commission (KIRC) in the seat reserved for a representative of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) On behalf of the Commission, I wish to express my **strong support** and **recommend** her confirmation.

In her first four-year term on the KIRC, Commissioner Lindsey provided a direct conduit to OHA allowing the KIRC to work closely with the trustees and staff to further the KIRC's mission objectives. The Hawaii State Aha Moku Advisory Committee (AMAC) stands in strong support of Gubernatorial Nominee, GM Carmen Lindsey for consideration and confirmation to the Kahoolawe Island Reserve Commission (KIRC), for a term to expire on June 30, 2023.

Carmen Kahulumealani Lindsey, more commonly and affectionately known as "Hulu" Lindsey is a native Hawaiian who has cultural knowledge of Kaho'olawe and is also very aware of how KIRC operates. She is a Trustee of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs representing the Island of Maui and understands the deep connection Maui has to Kahoolawe. Generational knowledge from kupuna of Maui bring forward the history of Kahoolawe – much which was never revealed. For instance, the traditional families of Honuaula Moku on Maui are directly connected to Kahoolawe. It was the Kuloloio 'Ohana from Honuaula, Maui that gave the place names of Kahoolawe to the island prior to western arrival. As one who keeps the traditions and cultural practices of Kahoolawe alive, Hulu Lindsey takes seriously the protection and perpetuation of the island's traditions and culture.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this measure. We urge you to approve the nomination of Carmen Lindsey to the Kahoolawe Island Reserve Commission.
