- 1 **Fiscal Implications:** Additional Deposit Beverage Container Program funding may be required
- 2 for additional administrative duties.
- 3 **Department Testimony:** The Department of Health has the following comments on HB1085:
- The deposit beverage distributors and manufacturers report and pay the deposit and
- 5 container fee as a single check to the Department of Health for the Statewide sales of deposit
- 6 beverages. However, under this measure deposit beverage distributors and manufacturers will be
- 7 required to track sales in each county in order to report and pay the correct amount for deposit
- 8 into each county subaccount.
- 9 Under this measure, the Department of Health would retain the majority of administrative
- duties. The Department of Health would continue to manage the collection of deposits and fees,
- financial reporting and reconciliation, issuance of permits, internal and external management of
- financial audits and certain enforcement activities. The Department of Health would need to
- expand the Deposit Beverage Container Program by creating and providing resources to track,
- audit, and interface with county deposit beverage container programs. It is not known if current
- revenue levels are sufficient or sustainable to support the Department of Health and counties
- deposit beverage container programs.
