- Fiscal Implications: HB220, HD1, Proposed SD1 appropriates \$2,374,847 in general funds to
- 2 support 5.0 full time equivalent (FTE) positions and operational funds for comprehensive family
- 3 planning services for fiscal years 2019-2020 and fiscal year 2020-2021. This proposed measure
- 4 reflects the appropriation priorities of the Governor's Executive Biennium Budget Request and
- 5 changes the means of financing (MOF) for five (5) permanent FTE employees and operational
- 6 funds from federal to general funds.
- 7 **Department Testimony:** The Department strongly supports this proposed measure that
- 8 appropriates funds for continued operations of the Department of Health (DOH) Family Planning
- 9 Program due to rule changes in the federal Title X program (42 CFR Part 59).
- 10 The DOH recognizes the importance of the Family Planning Program services and preventive
- 11 health services for low income, the underinsured and other individuals with limited access to
- services. The DOH Family Planning Program was established in 1972. For over 45 years, these
- 13 Family Planning services included contraceptive services, client-centered education (based on
- Hawaii Revised Statutes § 321-11.1 [2009]), non-directive counseling, and referrals. The
- Department directly funds these family planning services on six islands (Kauai, Oahu, Molokai,
- Maui, Lanai, and Hawaii) through 12 contracts at 31 services sites. Between July 1, 2016 and

- 1 June 30, 2017, the DOH Family Planning Program service providers served 16,002 unduplicated
- 2 clients across the state, of which 95% were women.
- 3 Using the Guttmacher Health Cost Calculator (https://data.guttmacher.org/calculator), the
- 4 Department estimates that from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017, publicly funded family planning
- 5 in Hawaii prevented: 3,250 unintended pregnancies, 1,530 unplanned births, 1,100 abortions,
- 6 620 miscarriages, 400 unplanned births after short (<18 months) inter-pregnancy intervals, 240
- 7 unplanned preterm/low-birth-weight births, 160 chlamydia infections, 20 gonorrhea infections,
- 8 20 pelvic inflammatory disease cases, and 10 HIV infections. This calculates to a total net
- 9 savings of \$26,651,670 to Hawaii.
- On March 4, 2019 the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services published in the Federal
- Register that the new 42 CFR Part 59 rules would go into effect on May 3, 2019. The new rules
- that govern the acceptance of funds will undermine the quality and success of our longstanding
- Family Planning Program. The Department believes that the following would occur due to
- changes in the Title X rules: 1) uninsured and low income women and men would have very
- 15 limited access to family planning services; 2) unintended pregnancies would increase; 3) teen
- pregnancies would increase as services ordinarily available at the clinics would be limited or
- 17 non-existent; 4) there would be an increase of births within the most vulnerable population and a
- potential increase in the use of public assistance funds; 5) sexually transmitted infections—
- including Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)—and pelvic inflammatory diseases would go
- 20 undetected and untreated increasing the rates of disease in communities; 6) infertility rates would
- 21 rise; 7) overall health outcomes and referrals to other non-family planning services (i.e. alcohol,
- behavioral health, etc.) would be compromised; and 8) health services programs and clinic
- 23 infrastructures in rural communities would be severely limited.
- The DOH reviewed the 2018 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 42 CFR Part 59, Docket No.:
- 25 HHS-OS-2018-0008 (RIN 0937-ZA00) Compliance With Statutory Program Integrity
- 26 Requirements for the Title X Family Planning Program. The Department found that the rules
- 27 would impose coercive standards of care on patients, subvert the nationwide network of family

- 1 planning providers that Title X supports, and diminish access to affordable care. These changes
- 2 will limit the options for persons accessing family planning program services thereby increasing
- 3 long-lasting negative impacts with threats to overall health and well-being.
- 4 If the new rules go into effect, we cannot accept Title X grant funds and need to replace federal
- 5 funding for important family planning services with state funds through this bill. This measure
- 6 will institutionalize the DOH Family Planning Program and solidify comprehensive family
- 7 planning options Hawaii residents, and allow DOH Family Planning Program service providers
- 8 to deliver voluntary, client-centered, non-directive, quality clinical family planning and related
- 9 preventive health information, education, counseling, and referrals to women and men, with
- priority given to low-income and uninsured individuals statewide.
- 11 DOH is committed to seeking those federal funds that support quality, comprehensive, evidence-
- based, medically accurate, and effective family planning services to supplement state funding.
- 13 Thank you for the opportunity to testify.

#### 14 Offered Amendments:

- 15 The department respectfully proposes three amendments relating to: 1) Title X family planning
- program, 2) a personal emergency response system tax credit, 3) EMS operational and collective
- bargaining funds, and 4) additional budget priorities.
- 18 Family Planning Program
- 19 Change lines 4 and 5 on page to read: "ADD POSITIONS AND FUNDS TO REPLACE
- 20 FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM [—TITLE X]." Suggest
- 21 modifying the language of the measure to reflect the appropriation as a recurring item in the
- 22 Program ID (HTH 560) budget.
- 23 Personal Emergency Response System Tax Credit

- 1 Regarding a proposed Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) tax credit program, the
- 2 department respectfully requests the following resources to implement and maintain the program,
- 3 contingent on enactment of the program, for program ID HTH-907/AP:
- FTE permanent Program Specialist, preferably SR-22
- \$25,000 annual operating funds
- Temporary exemption from chapter 91
- 7 The departments has no expertise with consumer electronic devices like PERS and little
- 8 expertise with tax credit programs. Uptake is expected to be high, perhaps thousands or tens of
- 9 thousands of applications due to the affordability of PERS, which range from \$20 to several
- 10 hundred dollars, as well as need in the community for frail kupuna, disabled persons, individuals
- at risk of "wandering" due to Alzheimer's disease or dementia, and others.
- 12 At least one new staff person is required to conceptualize a new program, promulgate
- administrative rules, exercise judgement on qualifying technologies and products, maintain
- 14 highly confidential records (at a minimum relating to health status, personal and family income,
- and social security numbers), and process voluminous paperwork driven by deadlines (tax
- 16 season).
- 17 Operational funds are required for procurement of a IT system that is secure and meets audit and
- customer service standards, as well as standard office supplies for what is likely an
- 19 administratively burdensome workflow due to various form filings, receipt processing, and
- 20 record-keeping.
- 21 Lastly, temporary exemption from chapter 91 is required to assure a tax credit program that shall
- apply to the 2019 tax year will be timely, and that the fiduciary integrity of the program is
- assured.

- 25 Funding for HTH 730 EMSIPSB: \$11,872,596 for FY 20 and \$15,040,191 for FY 21 to meet

Chairs Baker and Dela Cruz, Vice-Chairs Chang and Keith-Agaran and Committee Members:

The League of Women Voters of Hawaii offers comments on this bill, which appropriates funds for operating expenses of the Health Department, specifically for reproductive health care.

The League is dismayed that this important appropriation was overlooked or deliberately eliminated during the regular budget appropriations process. We are also dismayed that it is necessary to resort to gut and replace tactics on the original HB220 which authorized a pharmacy to provide customized medication packages to patients. Once again, same broad title for a bill, very different content, and questions about whether the Proposed SD1 version will have enough readings in each house of the legislature to enable legislators to evaluate the measure.

The Health Department program appropriation of \$2.3 million now called for in the Proposed SD1 would add positions and replace Federal Funds from the Title X Federal Family Planning Program. The League of Women Voters has supported the Title X program for decades, and we oppose efforts to restrict this funding by preventing any clinics that accept federal funds from referring women to other providers for an abortion. This "gag rule" undermines the right of women to learn about their medical options and determine for themselves which option is best.

Hawaii has joined 20 other states in a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of the rule, but meantime we must step up and replace Title X funding because despite the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and Hawaii's Prepaid Health Care Act, the gag rule would significantly reduce funding for medical services to Hawaii's uninsured, underinsured and low-income people.

Dear Chair Dela Cruz, Chair Baker, and Members of the Committees:

My name is Doris Segal Matsunaga and I am the Maternal Child Health Director at Kokua Kalihi Valley Comprehensive Family Services. Kokua Kalihi Valley strongly supports the intent of HB 220 HD 1 which is to establish a high quality state funded Hawaii Family Planning program whose medical standards are not dictated by the political ideology that the current administration in Washington is now imposing upon the federal Title X Family Planning program, nor dependent upon Title X for funding. We urge that the funding level be no less than \$2.4 million, which we understand to be the current funding level for Title X funded family planning services.

Kokua Kalihi Valley (KKV) is federally qualified community health center located on School Street near the tall Kuhio Park Terrace housing project. For at least the past 15 years, Title X family planning (FP) funds have helped to pay for FP medical services for over 1,000 Kalihi Valley women, men and teens, and for over 3,000 people to participate in outreach education in schools, churches, and community centers. We serve young parents with toddlers in tow, busy working women, and teens who walk-in after school. Title X funds at KKV pay for an accessible FP Walk-In Clinic open 6 full days/week where bilingual counselors provide pregnancy tests, STD tests, same day birth control, emergency contraception, free condoms, education and referrals. 95% of FP patients live on incomes at or below the federal poverty level (\$14,000 for 1, \$29,000 for family of 4). Loss of these critical FP funds will absolutely reduce services, hours and access for our most vulnerable and stressed teens and adults.

Even so, no ethical medical provider, nor Hawaii's Governor, will accept Title X funds if it means working under what has been called the new Title X "gag rule". These rules ban health care providers who participate in the Title X FP program from giving women full and complete information about their health care options, specifically information about abortion, even when they ask. This undermines basic principles of the patient-provider relationship. A long list of provider organizations including the AMA, ANA, ACOG, AAP and others oppose the new Title X rule.

Without full funding for the bill you are considering today, KKV and 12 other organizations on 6 islands providing family planning services to thousands of low & moderate income families would be forced to shut down or curtail vital women's health services, including early pregnancy tests and early prenatal care. The good news is that Hawaii already has in place the state expertise and infrastructure to administer such a program, and a network of experienced FP service providers including community health centers, hospitals, and Planned Parenthood clinics, now funded via the federal Title X program. Planned Parenthood and community health centers work collaboratively and neither can do this job alone.

Please give Hawaii women and their families in all parts of our state access to the full health care services they need by supporting HB 220 HD 1 and including \$2.4 million in the state budget this year. Thank you for this opportunity to testify in support of this important legislation.

As a section of the Nation's leading group of physicians dedicated to improving health care for women, the Hawai'i Section of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (HI ACOG) represents more than 200 obstetrician/gynecologist physicians in our state. HI ACOG strongly supports HB 220\_HD1\_SD1.

Many of our members work in Title X clinics throughout Hawai'i and know firsthand the value of these clinics and the work they do. The clinics that have been recipients of Title X funding depend on those funds to provide vital family planning and preventive health services for low-income, under-insured and uninsured individuals who may otherwise lack access to health care. These clinics serve individuals of all genders with services that include contraceptive counseling and provision of contraception, screening and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, screening for intimate partner violence, and pre-conception counseling.

We are grateful to Governor Ige for standing up to the Federal Administration and not putting the health care providers in our Title X clinics in the unethical position of keeping information from our patients. However, these clinics now need our help and need to replace the funds that they once received from Title X grants. In 2016, Title X funding served 13,335 people in Hawai'i. In 2015, Title X-supported services helped Hawai'i women to prevent 4,200 unintended pregnancy and 1,400 abortions. Our communities across Hawai'i need to be able to continue to access these critical health care services.

Hawaii Maternal and Infant Health Collaborative, founded in 2013, is a public private partnership committed to Improving Birth Outcomes and Reducing Infant Mortality. A critical component of improving birth outcomes is preconception care and a critical component of preconception care is the provision of contraception for women who wish to prevent pregnancy. **We stand in strong support of HB 220\_HD1\_SD1**.

Title X clinics provide vital family planning and preventive health services for low-income, under-insured and uninsured individuals who may otherwise lack access to health care. These clinics serve individuals of all genders with services that include contraceptive counseling and provision of contraception, screening and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, screening for intimate partner violence, and pre-conception counseling.

Access to qualified women's health service providers and organizations that provide relevant health care information are essential to maintain women's health. The Federal changes will prohibit the provision of educational services, comprehensive medical, and social services necessary for people to make freely informed, family planning decisions at clinical sites receiving Title X funds. We believe these proposed rules will have adverse impacts and implications for individuals in Hawaii. We are grateful to Governor Ige for standing up to the Federal Administration. However, these clinics now need our help and need to replace the funds that they once received from Title X grants. In 2016, Title X funding served 13,335 people in Hawaii. In 2015, Title X-supported services

helped Hawai'i women to prevent 4,200 unintended pregnancy and 1,400 abortions.<sup>1</sup> Our communities across Hawai'i need to be able to continue to access these critical health care services.

The Collaborative was developed in partnership with the Executive Office of Early Learning's Action Strategy with help from the Department of Health and National Governors' Association. The Action Strategy provides Hawaii with a roadmap for an integrated and comprehensive early childhood system, spanning preconception to the transition to Kindergarten. The Collaborative helps advance goals within the Action Strategy by focusing on ensuring that children have the best start in life by being welcomed and healthy. The Collaborative has completed a strategic plan and accompanying Logic Model, *The First 1,000 Days*, aimed at achieving the outcomes of 8% reduction in preterm births and 4% reduction in infant mortality. To date over 150 people across Hawaii have been involved in the Collaborative. These members include physicians and clinicians, public health planners and providers, insurance providers and health care administrators. The work is divided into three primary areas, preconception, pregnancy and delivery, and the first year of life, and coordinated by a cross sector leadership team. Work is specific, outcome driven, informed by data and primarily accomplished in small work groups.

Dear Chair Baker, Vice Chair Keith-Agaran, and Members of the Committee,

My name is Emma Ishihara, and I would like to submit testimony in strong support of HB 220, Proposed SD 1, which would allocate funds to replace the Title X family planning program funds from the federal government.

This bill is extremely important to the people of Hawaii because it would put aside funds that are important to sustaining reproductive health care facilities and services across the state. After the Trump Administration's Gag Rule was recently released, Hawaii and several other states pulled out of Title X funding to avoid being censored or being allowed to operate without giving patients medically accurate information. The decision was very important, but at the same time, those funds are also important to the recipients of Hawaii's family planning programs.

Hawaii has protected other health services that were attacked by the Trump Administration in the past such as those covered by the Affordable Care Act. The National Family Planning & Reproductive Health Association (2015) noted that attacks on Title X funding extend back even into the Obama Administration, decreasing 12.3% between fiscal year 2010 and fiscal year 2013. On top of this, other significant members of our state government have opposed the administration's Gag rule, including Governor David Ige. It follows that our legislation should maintain its stance in support of medical coverage for all and protect the services that would otherwise be removed by the Title X Gag.

Due to the nature of these services, many people who receive services through funding from Title X are people of color and those who do not have insurance. Planned Parenthood has also claimed that millions of people are going to be affected by the Title X Gag Rule (Everett, 2019). Tens of thousands of people in Hawaii receive family planning services with the help of Title X funding each year, and without it, they will be left to fend for themselves in the ridiculously expensive world of medicine.
