H.B. 804 RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM REGISTRATION FEES

House Committee on Public Safety, Veterans and Military Affairs

The Department of Transportation (DOT) supports this bill.

This bill seeks to expand the exemption from payment of vehicle registration fees for disabled veterans residing in Hawaii with a 100-percent disability rating, to increase the number of exempt vehicles from one to two. This bill in its current form would result in a loss of approximately \$4,800 to the State Highway Fund. If further revised to include those who are pre-retired, loss would increase to \$123,000. The DOT generally does not support exemptions, as reductions in revenue are detrimental to the health of the State Highway Fund; however, we recognize that these exemptions will assist our disabled veterans, and thus, we support this measure.
