Dear Chair Creagan and Committee Members,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide supportive testimony for HB938 relating to agriculture. This bill proposes to provide State support in the form of grants and loans to local farmers and ranchers who experienced losses due disasters. The establishment of an agriculture disaster fund program would help to address the significant disasters experienced in 2018 on all islands.

Hawai'i Island producers were negatively impacted by Hurricane Lane which brought unprecedented rainfall and exceptional flooding which caused loss of crops, livestock, as well as destruction and damages to farm and ranch landscapes, roads, fences and building infrastructure.

The eruption of Kīlauea caused over \$27.9 million in damage to crops, livestock and infrastructure. Perhaps more significant for impacted producers is many had their operation completely covered by lava tens of feet deep and now face years of effort and significant financial investment to restore their operations. Those eligible for payments from the federal government have found regulatory caps result in very limited recovery assistance. Federal and State loans may be precluded by existing debt, including loans taken out to recover from Hurricane Iselle four years prior, and the lack of collateral due to physical loses from the eruption.

Recovery for producers will be a long and expensive; thus, additional recovery options will be greatly appreciated. The State's expanded support of agriculture following disasters will contribute significantly to the overall resiliency and continued growth and development of this important portion of the economy.

The Committee on Agriculture and Environment's support of HB938 would be sincerely appreciated.
