H.B. 992 RELATING TO EXEMPTIONS FROM REGISTRATION FEES

House Committee on Public Safety, Veterans and Military Affairs

The Department of Transportation (DOT) supports this bill.

This bill seeks to expand the exemption from payment of vehicle registration fees for disabled veterans residing in Hawaii with a 100-percent disability rating, to include those who are pre-retired. Nevertheless, revisions currently included in this bill do not seem to meet that intent as HRS 249-31.5(4) has not been stricken; if deleted, it would result in an approximate \$118,000 decrease in vehicle registration revenues. The DOT generally does not support exemptions as reductions in revenue are detrimental to the health of the State Highway Fund; however, we recognize that these exemptions will assist our disabled veterans, and thus, we support this measure.

We also note that addition of language, "...and the tax imposed under this chapter" may not meet with any increased benefit to disabled veterans, as taxes noted are not authorized under HRS 249-31.
