Senate Bill 1063 proposes to amend Section 205-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) regarding wireless communication antenna land uses within the Conservation District by inserting language stipulating that communication antennas as defined in Section 205-4.5(a) (18), HRS, shall be camouflaged to blend in with the surrounding environment. The Department of Land and Natural Resources supports this measure and offers the following comment.

Conservation District Use Applications for wireless communication facilities are evaluated on a case by case basis. All new facilities are required to be camouflaged to blend into the surrounding environment.
