SB 2690 - RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII

Chair Kim, Vice Chair Kidani, and members of the committee:

The University of Hawai'i Community Colleges supports the intent of Senate Bill 2690. This initiative is to appropriate funds to subsidize travel expenses and/or tuition that gives Maui County students (18-20) opportunities for study abroad experiences.
