The State Public Charter School Commission ("Commission") appreciates the opportunity to submit this testimony in **SUPPORT of SB3037 SD1**. The Commission is grateful for the support of the Education Committee with the introduction and passage of this measure which makes house-keeping amendments to the governing charter school statute, Chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

In summary, this measure proposes the following changes:

- Section 1: Clarifies and consolidates authorizer reporting requirements for the annual report to the Board of Education (BOE) and the Legislature;
- Section 2: Streamlines the application process for new charter schools by removing a step that has proven to be redundant and unnecessary;
- Section 3: Clarifies and updates indicators and measures in the performance frameworks of the Charter Contract:
- Section 4: Removes redundant language pertaining to the annual report to the BOE and the Legislature; and
- Section 5: Amends the audit selection process by allowing a selection of auditors from a list of more than three auditors.
