The Hawaii Emergency Management Agency (HI-EMA) supports the intent of Senate Bill 346.

Senate Bill 346 restricts the planting of large trees along evacuation routes and authorizes the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency to identify large trees along evacuation routes and trim, spray, or remove large trees if the trees have the potential to obstruct the evacuation route. Defines evacuation route. Makes appropriations.

Note: My comments represent HI-EMA concerns at the state emergency management level only. I would defer to the separate comment/testimonies of the county emergency management agencies, as they would be the jurisdictions impacted by this legislation at the local level.
