The EPA has ruled that all cesspools in Pahoa must be converted in order to protect water quality, but this threatens the economic vitality of the business community along the main street. The only solution to the problem is a sewer feasibility study and/or wastewater treatment plant to address the problem while protecting Pahoa from becoming a ghost town. The Puna Community Development Plan recognizes the problem, which requires funding. Please provide it. Mahalo.
