The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) Committee on Beneficiary Advocacy and Empowerment will recommend that the OHA Board of Trustees adopt a position of **COMMENT** on SB681, which would prohibit a member of the Board of Trustees from serving more than two-consecutive four-year terms.

OHA respectfully suggests that it is unclear whether this bill intends to include trustees already sitting on the Board at the time of the bill's effective date, and if so, how the bill would impact sitting trustees who have already been elected for two consecutive terms. If it is the intent of this committee to not prevent sitting trustees who have already served for the maximum terms, we are requesting the language be added to reflect that intention.

My name is Esther Kia'aina of Nanakuli, Oahu. I am testifying in support of SB 730, which establishes term limits of not more than three terms or twelve years for members of the Board of Trustees, Office of Hawaiian Affairs.

I also support SB 681, which prohibits a member of the Board of Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs from serving more than two consecutive four-year terms and permits reelection after an absence of a full four-year term.
