S.B. 824, S.D.1 RELATING TO RENTALS OF MOPEDS AND MOTOR SCOOTERS.

Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and Health Senate Committee on Judiciary

The Department of Transportation **supports** S.B. 824, S.D.1.

This bill, in part, prohibits the operating of a motor scooter and moped from any rental company unless the person wears a safety helmet provided by the rental company or person, although this requirement does not apply to a person who possesses a valid license from any state to operate a motorcycle.

In Hawai'i, according to State fatality data, during the calendar years of 2016 - 2018, of the 23 motor scooter and moped operator fatalities, 22 operators, or 96% of the operators, were not wearing helmets.

This bill will help to reduce the amount of these types of fatalities.

Yet there are no lessons, minimal instruction or a helmet law to protect our loved ones riding a two wheeled motorized bike that they are not familiar with when they visit Hawaii. Most visitors that rent moped and scooters have minimal to zero experience riding these motorized bikes. Hawaii requires a helmet to be worn on Construction sites, also their motorcycle police force wear a helmet for their safety. So the knowledge of helmet/hard hat PPE safety is there, just being ignored.

Our daughters Death certificate reads "Blunt Trauma to the Head". A couple days ago there also was another moped accident in Maui with Head Trauma. I'm unaware of the outcome of this young 25 year old man, but a head trauma can be prevented with the use of a helmet. The head is fragile, needs to be protected and all the data supports that a helmet helps saves lives.

The Hawaiian locals are very vocal on Social Media in regards to the importance of wearing a helmet. There is even a post where someone states references Moped/Scooter riders as "Organ Donors".

When these accidents happen it affects so many and knowing that some of these can be prevented, is incomprehensible.

This is made even more important when you combine the fact that mopeds\scooters do not operate in the same manner as most other cycles. With the lowest center of gravity of almost any motorized cycle it is neither smooth nor graceful. It is underpowered when traveling roads with full size vehicles. A strong cross wind will push you easily and almost every renter of a scooter/moped probably has no knowledge of this.

Having worked in the ER and for the trauma program since 2005, I have seen far too many unnecessary injuries and deaths due to motorcycles and mopeds, including close family and friends. Many of these could have been prevented had the operator worn a helmet. Tourists come here and rent mopeds without particularly being skilled in operating a moped and more so, without knowing our roads. I ardently support the requirement of helmets for moped riders, this can only save lives. Residents have vehemently rejected helmet laws for decades, but if we target just moped rentals it may get passed and save at least some lives, especially those who are not used to operating mopeds on a daily basis and are not knowledgeable of our roads. Of 23 motor scooter and moped operator fatalities from 2016-2018, 22 operators were not wearing helmets. Helmet use can reduce the risk of death by 42 percent.
