S.B. 824 RELATING TO RENTALS OF MOPEDS AND MOTOR SCOOTERS

Senate Committee on Transportation

The Department of Transportation **supports** S.B. 824.

This bill, in part, prohibits the operating of a motor scooter and moped from any rental company unless the person wears a safety helmet provided by the rental company or person provided that this requirement does not apply to a person who possesses a valid license from any state to operate a motorcycle.

In Hawaii, according to State fatality data, during the calendar years of 2016 - 2018, of the 23-motor scooter and moped operator fatalities; 22 operators or 96 percent were not wearing helmets.

This bill will help reduce the amount of these types of fatalities.

I witnessed the outcome of Lexi's accident first hand. I covered her body. I know that a helmet would not of changed the outcome of this horrible blot on Maui. But for the sake of the next son or daughter that thinks a moped/scooter would be fun, because how hard could it be, make them go home safe. Make them wear protection if they are not licensed. Let us be the uncles and aunties who look out for our Ohana in spite of ourselves.

I have been on two wheels since I was 8 years old. that would make 41 years of riding, both on and off road. I began working at a motoX park in CA at age 11 and know first hand that helmets save lives.

That being said, I don't believe that a licensed driver of a motorcycle should be forced to wear a helmet. that is specifically because this person has the proven knowledge to be licensed and as such can make an informed decision.

An amateur rider is another story. They may have background in riding a motorized two wheel vehicle, but we definitely know they have not been proven educated enough to make an informed decision regarding the safety of both themselves and others. This is made even more important when you combine the fact that mopeds\scooters do not operate in the same manner as most other cycles. With the lowest center of gravity of almost any motorized cycle it is neither smooth nor graceful. It is underpowered when traveling roads with full size vehicles. A strong cross wind will push you easily and almost every renter of a scooter/moped probably has no knowledge of this.

If you truly do not wish to wear a helmet, be licensed to ride.

SB824 targets untrained and unlicensed visitors by requiring scooter and moped rental companies to provide a helmet if the individual does not have one of their own. Aloha, my name is Jack Nordby

I am a resident of Maui for nearly 8 years now. I am a long time motorcycle enthusiast and I am an experienced rider for over 30 years. I know the dangers and pitfalls of riding a motorized vehicle even as an experienced rider. But there is no way that any person that has not been licensed and/or educated in riding a motorcycle or scooter or any motorized bicycle can operate one of these safely considering all of the obstacles and unknown road hazards that one can encounter on any given day.

In my 30 years of riding, I discovered that rain and weather changes, lane changes, bad pavement, poor visibility to other drivers, slick roads, unknown roads and many other hazards that make riding a motorcycle or scooter, a strictly defensive mode of transportation. Those who are well experienced expect these unexpected hazards. But a person without this riding experience cannot know what to expect and how to safely maneuver out of danger. Because they have no experience to save themselves, the best help that we can offer to the inexperienced rider, visiting our islands is to protect that part of the body most apt to injury and/or death in the possibility of an accident.

In my opinion and experience of riding, requiring a helmet to those who are unlicensed in 2 wheel motor vehicles, will be the difference between life, injury and death for many people who visit Hawaii and want to enjoy touring our islands on these scooters.

I do consider myself an expert motorcycle rider, and I cringe whenever I see people on scooters who are not wearing helmets and I can tell immediately that they are not experienced riders.

We don't need any more roadside memorials. Please, let's pass this helmet law and make sure that everyone is safe and can enjoy our islands for years to come.

I support bill numbers HB636 and SB824 that was introduced to the Hawai'i State Legislature in January 18, 2019 for a helmet safety law RELATING TO RENTALS OF MOPEDS AND MOTOR SCOOTERS. The purpose of this is to mitigate fatalities and traumatic brain injuries on Hawaii's roadways by strengthening helmet safety laws as they relate to mopeds and motor scooters that are rented.

Alexis "Lexi" Patrice Jenkins visited Maui for the first time in August 2017 before the new school year was to begin at San Diego. She was 24 young with a lot of life ahead of her. Lexi had rented a scooter for the day without a helmet and collided with a truck in the Makena/Wailea area near where I worked. Sadly, due to the nature of the accident Lexi had no possibility of surviving. Lexi was the only child to Tim and Danielle Jenkins. Their life is forever changed because their daughter took a trip to Maui, rented a moped without a helmet and never returned home.

We have a responsibility as human beings to keep people safe when visiting or living on our beautiful islands. I have family that visit me from the mainland and I never thought a second about them wearing a helmet when they rented a moped/scooter for a day. The Jenkins paid the ultimate price in losing a child. They lost their ONLY child. No one should have to suffer that loss. No parent should have to out live their children let alone their ONLY child! We are losing too many visitors and people from our own community to something that could maybe prevent the death of a loved one or your loved one living the rest of their lives with a traumatic brain injury.

I feel strongly that our Hawaiian Islands needs a helmet safety law!

I Danielle Jenkins support Bill SB824 as this bill hits very close to home. We lost our only child Alexis Jenkins in a scooter accident in Maui August 15, 2017. Our daughter held a Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do, made the Varsity Golf team her Sophomore year of High School. Lex Modeled, Sang, did Yoga, snowboarded, snow skied, wakeboarded, water skied, solo skydiver, equestrian etc...Lex even ran for Miss California 2016. Most of these sports require lessons, helmets and special training. Yet there are no lessons, minimal instruction or a helmet law to protect our loved ones riding a two wheeled motorized bike that they are not familiar with when they visit Hawaii. Most visitors that rent moped and scooters have minimal to zero experience riding these motorized bikes. Hawaii requires a helmet to be worn on Construction sites, also their motorcycle police force wear a helmet for their safety. So the knowledge of helmet/hard hat PPE safety is there, just being ignored.

Our daughters Death certificate reads "Blunt Trauma to the Head". A couple days ago there also was another moped accident in Maui with Head Trauma. I'm unaware of the outcome of this young 25 year old man, but a head trauma can be prevented with the use of a helmet. The head is fragile, needs to be protected and all the data supports that a helmet helps saves lives.

The Hawaiian locals are very vocal on Social Media in regards to the importance of wearing a helmet. There is even a post where someone references Moped/Scooter riders as "Organ Donors".

When these accidents happen it affects so many and knowing that some of these can be prevented, is incomprehensible.

This will not change our life but hopefully this bill if passed will change the fate of someone else's loved one. The pain is real, raw and deep!
We have almost 15,000 people that have visited lexislaw808.com. This website is raising the awareness on the dangers of riding a scooter/moped in Hawaii and the importance of wearing a helmet.
Because of the current infrastructure issues on the islands, I believe it is imperative too veer on the side of caution and be proactive in implementing a helmet law.
I am respectfully imploring Congress to do the right thing and move forward with this law.
