### RELATING TO STATE LIBRARY SYSTEM

Senate Bill No. 978 specifies funds of \$10 or less in the unclaimed property trust fund shall escheat to the State and transferred to the libraries special fund upon expiration of the ten-year time limitation. The bill also increases the threshold for escheatment of unclaimed funds to the general fund from amounts less than \$100 to amounts less than \$250 after the expiration of the ten-year time limitation.

The Department is providing comments on this bill. Currently, Section 523A-19, HRS, already establishes a ten-year time limitation for owners to file a claim for funds \$100 or less deposited in the unclaimed property trust fund. These funds would escheat to the State and be transferred to the general fund upon expiration of the ten-year time limitation. Please note that while increasing the threshold amount from \$100 to \$250 to escheat to the general fund, escheatment of unclaimed funds of \$10 or less to the libraries special fund will result in a loss of revenue to the general fund.
