In consideration of SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 34 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT WAIOHULI-KEOKEA HOMESTEADS, KIHEI, MAUI, FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING

SEAWALL, ROCK REVETMENT, AND STEPS, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON Senate Concurrent Resolution 34 requests the authorization to issue a term, non-exclusive easement covering 668 square feet, more or less, portion of state submerged lands identified as tax map key: (2) 3-9-012: seaward of 003, at Waiohuli-Keokea Homesteads, Kihei, Maui, for the use, repair, and maintenance of the existing seawall, rock revetment, and steps constructed thereon, pursuant to Section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS). The Department of Land

and Natural Resources ("Department") supports this Administration concurrent resolution.

The current owners of the abutting property, Robin M. and Jennifer Downs Kean, Trustees of the Robin M. Kean Revocable Living Trust dated October 1, 2015, and Jennifer Downs Kean and Robin M. Kean, Trustees of the Jennifer Downs Kean Revocable Living Trust dated October 1, 2015, worked with the Department to resolve the encroachment. The improvements were found encroaching on State lands located makai of the shoreline and such area should be considered as As required by Section 171-53, HRS, the Board of Land and Natural submerged lands. Resources ("Board") may lease submerged lands "with the prior approval of the Governor and the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution". At its meeting on June 9, 2017, under agenda item D-9, the Board approved the issuance of a term, non-exclusive easement of approximately 650 square feet for the seawall and rock revetment, and subsequently at its meeting on April 26, 2019, under agenda item D-6, the Board approved the amendment of the easement to include concrete steps and an increase of the easement area to 668 square feet.
