
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$69,170,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 eighth representative district, as follows:

7 1. August Ahrens elementary school, Oahu

8 Construction for whole school

9 renovation, ground and site

10 improvements; equipment and

11 appurtenances.

12 Construction	\$1,350,000
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13 Total funding	\$1,350,000
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14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

 11 Additional design and construction to
 12 complete DREAMS building.
 13 Design \$350,000
 14 Construction \$25,300,000
 15 Total funding \$25,650,000
 16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 17 shall be expended by the department of education.

18 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 19 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 20 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;

2 of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
