

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The director of finance is authorized to issue SECTION 1. 2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$69,170,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021 5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-6 eighth representative district, as follows: 7 1.
