
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2019-2020:

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:

6 A. August Ahrens elementary school, Oahu

7 Design and construction for improvements to the
8 current parking lot and the addition of a new parking
9 lot; and ground and site improvements.

10 Design \$300,000

11 Construction \$1,750,000

12 Total funding \$2,050,000

13 B. Honowai elementary school, Oahu

14 Design and construction for covered walkways in
15 multiple areas; ground and site improvements; and
16 equipment and appurtenances.
