BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part XI, to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291C- Parking in front of mailboxes. In any county
- 5 with a population of 500,000 or more, the stopping, standing, or
- 6 parking of vehicles in front of a mailbox that faces a roadway
- 7 and to which the United States Postal Service delivers mail is
- 8 prohibited from Monday through Saturday between the hours of
- 9 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.; provided that this section shall not
- 10 apply to postal delivery vehicles."
- 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
