## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO INCLUDE TRAINING, COURSES, AND CURRICULUM RELATED TO THE MECHANICS, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRIC VEHICLES, HYDROGEN VEHICLES, AND OTHER ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLES IN ITS SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the impacts of climate change are becoming 1 increasingly urgent, and the State recognizes the importance of 2 3 eliminating fossil fuels and transitioning to clean energy 4 across all sectors; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the use of fossil fuels is the State's primary contributor to greenhouse gas emissions, and the State's 7 dependence on fossil fuels drains the economy of billions of 8 dollars each year; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the transportation sector accounts for the use of 11 over two-thirds of the oil imported into the State; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, drivers spend nearly \$2,000,000,000 annually on gasoline and diesel for their cars and trucks, and the 15 combustion of that fuel releases approximately eleven billion 16 pounds of climate-changing carbon dioxide into the atmosphere 17 each year; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Hawai'i currently has upwards of ten thousand 20 electric vehicles on the road, and that number will continue to 21 increase as electric vehicles become more readily available and 22 23 cost-effective for the public, and as the State expands its electric vehicle charging infrastructure; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Hawai'i ranks in the top five states nationally for 26 27 adoption of electric vehicles based on the percentage of 28 vehicles purchased; and 29

WHEREAS, mechanics and others who perform repair and 1 2 maintenance of electric vehicles require special tools, safety equipment, and technician training; 3 4 5 WHEREAS, it is estimated that only three percent of automotive technicians have the skillset to work on electric 6 7 vehicles; and 8 WHEREAS, only limited courses focused on electric vehicle 9 mechanics, repair, and maintenance are offered through the 10 University of Hawaii and Department of Education programs; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, given the increasing adoption of electric vehicles across the State, this body finds that it is necessary to 14 develop a workforce of automotive technicians who are trained in 15 16 the mechanics, repair, and maintenance of electric vehicles, hydrogen vehicles, and other alternative fuel vehicles; now, 17 therefore, 18 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 21 2020, that this body urges the University of Hawaii System and 22 the Department of Education to include training, courses, and 23 24 curriculum related to the mechanics, repair, and maintenance of electric vehicles, hydrogen vehicles, and other alternative fuel 25 vehicles in its school programs; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Resolution be transmitted to President of the University of 29 30 Hawaii System, Chairperson of the Board of Education, and Superintendent of Education. 31 32 33 whe E.
