HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION TO IMPLEMENT THE USE OF TRAFFIC CALMING SYSTEMS TO REGULATE SPEEDING ON SURFACE STREETS.

WHEREAS, traffic congestion is often cited as a 1 contributing factor to aggressive driving, including speeding; 2 3 and 4 WHEREAS, the increase in traffic congestion and speeding 5 throughout the State has increased the risk of harm to drivers, 6 passengers, bicyclists, and pedestrians; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, all vehicles, including automobiles, motorcycles, 10 mopeds, and bicycles are capable of speeding; and 11 12 WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of the United States Department of 13 Transportation, speeding was involved in forty-seven percent of 14 all traffic fatalities in Hawaii; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, because traffic safety is of paramount importance 18 to residents and visitors alike, implementation of more effective methods to regulate speeding and enforce speed limits, 19 including traffic calming systems, is necessary; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, traffic calming is a method used to regulate 23 speeding by managing the flow of traffic using physical designs and devices, including narrow lanes, speed bumps, speed tables, 24 raised crosswalks and intersections, and roundabouts; now, 25 26 therefore. 27 28 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 29 2020, that the Department of Transportation Services of the City 30 and County of Honolulu is requested to consider and take action 31

1	to implement traffic calming systems to regulate speeding on
