A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER RECRUITMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:
4 "§302A- Recruitment and retention incentives; public
5 school teachers. The department, subject to the availability of
6 funds, may provide monetary or other incentives to enhance the
7 recruitment and retention of public school teachers. Incentives
8 may include housing expenses, relocation expenses, salary
9 differentials, and bonuses. The department may adopt rules
10 pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this
11 section."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.


13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
