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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$32,706,200 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 thirteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7    1.   Kauluwela Elementary School

8           A.   Construction of walkway covers.

6 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
9 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
12 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
13 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 14 (1) The sums appropriated in items (1) through (4) shall  
15 be expended by the department of education;
- 16 (2) The sum appropriated in item (5) shall be expended by  
17 the department of accounting and general services; and
- 18 (3) The sum appropriated in item (6) shall be expended by  
19 the Hawaii health systems corporation.
