A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the biosecurity of
- 2 agriculture in Hawaii is one of the most significant issues
- 3 facing agriculture production. The legislature also finds that,
- 4 on average, one new invasive species enters the State per day,
- 5 and several dozen invasive species have already successfully
- 6 established themselves in the State. Control of invasive
- 7 species is based on monitoring crop health, identifying problems
- 8 in collaboration with the department of agriculture, researching
- 9 the causes of the problems, and developing remediation
- 10 solutions.
- 11 The legislature believes that additional staff positions
- 12 within the University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture
- 13 and human resources are necessary to protect the future of
- 14 agriculture on Oahu. These positions include an entomology
- 15 extension specialist who will instruct producers on how to
- 16 monitor and identify harmful and beneficial insects and develop

- 1 and teach farmers the proper method of control of harmful
- 2 insects; a plant pathologist extension specialist with a focus
- 3 in fungal diseases, who will train farmers in integrated disease
- 4 management and extend the information developed by the extension
- 5 specialist; and a pesticide extension specialist, who will be
- 6 responsible for evaluating the efficacy of chemicals used in
- 7 conventional and organic production to provide the information
- 8 necessary to label those chemicals for specific crops.
- 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to make an
- 10 appropriation to the University of Hawaii college of tropical
- 11 agriculture and human resources for an ornamental and landscape
- 12 entomology extension specialist, plant pathologist extension
- 13 specialist, and pesticide extension specialist.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 17 following positions in the University of Hawaii college of
- 18 tropical agriculture and human resources:
- (1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) ornamental and
- 20 landscape entomology extension specialist position;

- 1 (2) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) plant pathologist
 2 extension specialist position; and
 3 (3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) pesticide extension
 4 specialist position.
 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
 6 Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human resources for
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 2, 2050.
