A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that existing law allows		
2	firearms to be lent to an adult for up to seventy-five days		
3	without any background check or notice to the government that a		
4	firearm has been lent to a person who does not have a permit fo		
5	that weapon. The legislature further finds that this is not		
6	consistent with the rest of the firearm regulations, which		
7	requires background checks and permitting for all gun		
8	transferees.		
9	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:		
10	(1) Specify that a rifle or shotgun may be lent to an		
11	adult who is twenty-one years or older;		
12	(2) Repeal the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun		
13	without a permit;		
14	(3) Restrict the lending of a rifle or shotgun to twelve		
15	hours;

1	(4)	Repeal language that authorized the lending of a rifle
2		or shotgun outside of the State for up to seventy-five
3		days;
4	(5)	Require that an adult who is borrowing a firearm
5		either possess a firearm permit or personally own or
6		possess a registered firearm, and is not prohibited
7		from owning or possessing a firearm; and
8	(6)	Prohibit a person from knowingly lending a firearm, in
9		addition to a person who is prohibited from owning or
10		possessing a firearm, to a person who does not have a
11		firearm permit or does not own or possess a registered
12		firearm.
13	SECT	ION 2. Section 134-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by	y amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
15	"(c)	Any lawfully acquired rifle or shotgun may be lent to
16	an adult	who is twenty-one years of age or older for use within
17	the State	for a period not to exceed [fifteen days without a
18	permit;	twelve hours; provided that [where the rifle or shotgun
19	is to be	used outside of the State, the loan may be for a period
20	not to ex	eeed seventy five days.] the adult borrowing a rifle or

shotgun possesses a permit pursuant to section 134-2 or owns or

- 4 (d) No person shall knowingly lend a firearm to any person
- 5 who does not have a permit pursuant to section 134-2, does not
- 6 own or possess a firearm that is registered pursuant to section
- 7 134-3, or is prohibited from ownership or possession of a
- 8 firearm under section 134-7."
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Firearms; Lending; Firearm Permit; Firearm Registration

Description:

Specifies that a rifle or shotgun may be lent to an adult who is twenty-one years of age or older. Repeals the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun without a permit. Restricts the lending of a rifle or shotgun to twelve hours. Repeals language that authorized the use of a rifle or shotgun outside of the State for up to seventy-five days. Requires an adult who is borrowing a firearm to have either a firearm permit or a registered firearm, and is not prohibited to own or possess a firearm. Prohibits a person from lending a firearm, in addition to a person who is prohibited from owning or possessing a firearm, to a person who does not have a firearm permit or does not have a registered firearm.
