A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that noise pollution is a
2	serious problem affecting quality of life, particularly in urban
3	areas. Loud internal combustion engine mopeds are significant
4	contributors that have raised ongoing concerns in communities
5	throughout the State. Mopeds with factory mufflers are often
6	many times louder and noisier than larger motorcycles that have
7	greater engine displacement and robust exhaust baffles.
8	The purpose of this Act is to, beginning January 1, 2022,
9	prohibit a retailer from selling or offering for sale any
10	combustion engine-powered moped unless the moped was initially
11	purchased in a consumer transaction prior to January 1, 2022.
12	SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
13	adding a new chapter to title 17 to be appropriately designated
14	and to read as follows:
15	"CHAPTER
16	MOPEDS
17	§ -1 Definitions. For purposes of this chapter:

- 1 "Moped" shall have the same meaning as that term is defined
- 2 in section 286-2.
- 3 "Retailer" means a person or entity that engages in the
- 4 practice of selling mopeds to consumers.
- 5 Sale of new combustion engine-powered mopeds;
- 6 prohibited. (a) Beginning January 1, 2022, no retailer shall
- 7 sell or offer for sale any combustion engine-powered moped
- 8 unless the moped was initially purchased in a consumer
- 9 transaction prior to January 1, 2022.
- 10 (b) This section shall not be construed to prohibit any
- 11 individual or retailer from reselling, renting, or offering for
- 12 resale or rent a combustion engine-powered moped that was
- 13 initially purchased in a consumer transaction prior to
- 14 January 1, 2022.
- 15 § -3 Civil penalty; enforcement. Any person who
- 16 violates this chapter shall be fined not more than \$1,000 for
- 17 each separate offense. Each violation shall constitute a
- 18 separate offense."
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 18, 2050.
